

King's Kids Preschool

King's Kids Preschool offers a program for three and four year old children. Its purpose is to make available to children a growth experience that includes Christian values and allows for the physical, emotional, intellectual and social development of each child through cooperation with others of the same age.

STANDARDS

Our program is in compliance with the standards set by the Minnesota State Department of Human Services.

We are licensed for children 3 through 5 years of age, with the capacity of 20 children per class. There will be a ratio of one staff person per 10 children. Each class will be taught by a certified teacher.

PROGRAM

Our program consists of a lesson for each day that includes reading and math readiness, language and listening skills, and an appreciation of the world around the child.

We have a "show and share" time that encourages self-expression. Music and rhythm activities develop listening, enjoyment of sound and movement.

Christian values give children a framework within which to build healthy relationships.

Group games aid self-confidence and social

FOR WHOM

We have classes for children who are three and four years of age by September 1, 2010.

No child will be discriminated against because of race, national origin, creed or religion. Enrollment of children with handicaps will be contingent upon approval of the State Dept. of Human Services. Applications will be considered in regard to date received and age of the child.

Children must be toilet trained.

skills.

Free play allows for creativity and self-expression in the following areas:

Art Media (pasting, cutting, painting, and coloring)

Manipulative Equipment (blocks, puzzles, interlocking sets, etc.)

Science/Math (experiments, magnifying glasses and objects to investigate, scales, gifts from nature, magnets, etc.)

Large Muscle Play (tracks, foam blocks, balance beam, trucks, etc.)

Sensory (sandbox, playdough, waterplay, finger-painting, etc.)

We emphasize praising when behavior is good rather than criticizing inappropriate behavior.



TUITION

Tuition is divided into 8 1/2 monthly installments for your convenience, the half payment being for the month of May.

2 days/week - \$79.00 per month

3 days/week - \$113.00 per month

We maintain a ratio of 1 staff member to 10 children.

Tuition is due on the first of each month. A late fee of \$5.00 is charged after the 15th. A 30-day written notice is necessary for withdrawal. Tuition will then be charged only for the period of time the child has attended. There is no reduction of tuition for absence due to illness or vacation.

If your tuition will be late, please notify the Director, Cindy Hanson, 651 633 2240. A returned check will be charged an additional \$10.00.

REGISTRATION

In order to reserve a place in the class of your choice, send in the completed registration form (enclosed) and a \$40.00 registration fee. The registration fee is non-refundable and does not apply to the first month's tuition. We will send a confirmation letter after your registration is received.

There will be an Ice Cream Social near the end of August. This is a chance to meet the staff and some of your classmates.

Information concerning the first week of school will be sent to you several weeks before the beginning of school. Classes and/or ages may be combined at the discretion of the preschool staff.



WHERE

King's Kids Preschool meets in the Education Wing of Atonement Lutheran Church, Silver Lake Rd. at Rice Creek Rd., New Brighton, MN.

MEDICAL & IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

The enclosed Immunization form MUST be filled out and returned BY/ON the first day your child attends school. Please note the required vaccines per age of your child.

The enclosed Medical form MUST be filled out and returned to school no later than 30 days after the start of school by a new student. This form must be filled out and signed by a physician.

Students are required to have a new

medical form filled out every two years with updates when there is a change in their health status or in the immunization records. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS STATE MEDICAL REQUIREMENT MAY RESULT IN OUR ASKING A CHILD TO LEAVE SCHOOL until an Immunization record and/or medical form is received.



RELIGION

King's Kids Preschool is an outreach program of Atonement Lutheran Church.

We say a non-denominational prayer before snack time. At Thanksgiving we thank God for our food, families and homes. Christmas is celebrated by singing songs and reading stories about the birth of Baby Jesus.

King's Kids Preschool children come from many different cultural backgrounds with a variety of beliefs; therefore, we do not read Bible stories or teach any Lutheran Doctrine.

CALENDAR

ORIENTATION & CONFERENCES

Orientation and pre-admission conferences will be held the first week of school. You will be notified by mail regarding the actual day and time.

Parent Visit sessions are held in January. Parents are invited to spend a day at school with their child and evaluate their child's progress and the preschool program.

Scheduled Parent/Teacher conferences will be held in the Fall and Spring. However, the teachers are always available for personal or telephone conferences if the need arises.

Parents are encouraged to visit as frequently as possible in order to share this preschool experience with their child.

TRANSPORTATION

Parents must arrange their own transportation for their child. Class lists will be available at the Open House to aid in car pool arrangements. Your child will not be released to any one without prior written consent.
