Psalm 23:1

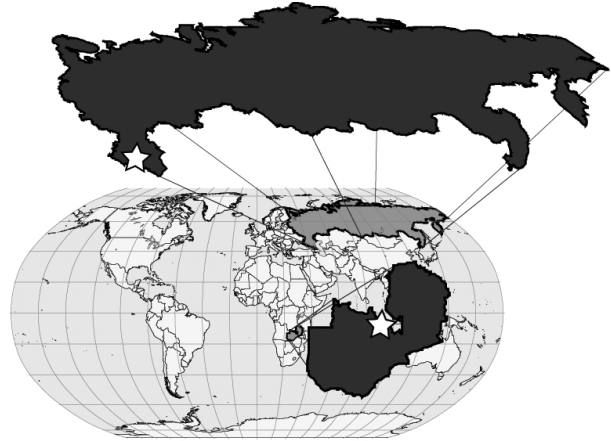
